HOSTOS COMMUNITY COLLEGE ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR FALL EVENING CLASSES

Beginning on September 10, 1973, men and women will be able to matriculate toward a degree at Hostos Community College on a part-time basis during the evening hours, it was announced today. As fully matriculated students, they will attend evening classes tuition-free, provided that they hold a high school diploma or the equivalent and are bona fide residents of New York City.

The college's new extended day session was established to meet the needs of working adults or persons otherwise unable to attend regularly scheduled daytime classes. Credit-bearing courses in the liberal arts program and English-as-a-second language courses will be offered from 4:30 in the afternoon until 8:45 in the evening, Monday through Thursday. In addition, a limited number of openings now exist in the medical secretarial science program and the child care program and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Courses will be offered in English and in Spanish.

Applications to the part-time evening degree program are now being accepted by the college's office of admissions. Persons who wish to obtain further information about applications are advised to phone the office of admissions (993-8000, ext. 312,313) from 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Monday -

Friday. They may visit the office of admissions (room 236) in person from 9:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. on Mondays and from 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Tuesday - Friday. To meet the anticipated flow of queries, Ray Sheenan, director of admissions, has indicated that his office will be open on Saturday, May 5, 12, 19, and 26, from 11:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Questions about the extended day session should be directed to Mr. Sheenan.
