Abstract

Bronx Community College Ephemera consists of promotional materials, brochures and general information on scheduled and prospective musical performances and lectures held within Gould Memorial Library, and a small number of audio recordings of Bronx Community functions.

Custodial History

The Bronx Community College Ephemera Collection was donated to Archives and Special Collections in 2015 by Bronx Community College.

Processing Information

The collection was processed and cataloged in 2017-2018.

Historical Note

Bronx Community College was founded in 1957 to increase access to public higher-education to the Bronx. In 1973 the College moved into its current location at the University Heights campus which had been vacated by New York University.

Gould Memorial Library was completed in 1899 to serve what was then a satellite campus for New York University. After Bronx Community College moved into the campus in 1973, Gould Memorial Library was no longer used as a library and was instead opened to host musical performances and lectures.

Scope and Content

The Bronx Community College Ephemera collection consists of 2.75 linear feet of promotional materials and general information on scheduled and prospective musical acts and lectures held within Gould Memorial Library and a small number of audio recordings of BCC functions.

Series I is composed of ephemera pertaining to Bronx Community College from 1991 to 2007. Items included are phone directories, fundraising information, a binder of information about films shot on the University Heights campus, promotional material, and information about landmarks on campus such as Gould Memorial Library.

Series II largely consists of concert programs from 1973 to 1977. Many of the programs document performances held at Gould Memorial Library. Other ephemera within this series includes concert advertisements, event calendars, and general information about various performers.

Series III contains four recordings of Bronx Community College functions between 1954 and 1998 on vinyl record, magnetic audio tape, and VHS tape.
