Scope and Content Note

The Bronx Community College Marketing and Communications Department Photograph Collection consists of 8.5 linear feet of photographs taken by or at the behest of the Marketing and Communications Department of Bronx Community College. The original purpose of the photographs was to document events, students, and faculty of Bronx Community College for possible use in marketing materials such as advertisements. The most common subjects of the photographs are commencements and the annual Run the Bronx 10K Run event.
