The meeting was called to order by Dr. Colston.

I. Panel Discussion

C. Polowczyk presented his feelings about the new budget and how it affects BCC.

R. Williams presented his letter to government officials.

R. Gosselin expressed the CUNY faculty feelings of lack of communication and consultation with faculty on the part of the BHE.

H. Harris stated that there was a lack of faculty response to important issues, and that the PSC is presenting bills and court injunctions regarding BHE actions.

D. Cancienne clarified retrenchment guidelines.

M: Rosenstock called for redirection of national priorities with greater consideration given to education.

M. Horn, in presenting a summary, stated that BCC has a special role within the "American Dream of rising expectations." In order to survive BCC must tighten its belt while at all times considering the needs of the students.

II. Proposals & Petitions Presented by Senators

Various proposals and resolutions concerning BCC's reaction to budget cuts were presented. It was decided that the Executive Committee would prepare an appropriate resolution to be distributed widely to elected and appointed city, state and federal officials.
