History of the Center for the Study of Free-Reed Instruments

The CSFRI fostered research and provided information on free-reed instruments from 1999 through 2014 under the Barry S. Brook Center for Musical Research and Documentation. The center published *The Free-Reed Journal* (1999 – 2003), and collaborated with the International Concertina Association to publish the *Papers of the International Concertina Association* (2004-2013). The center sponsored a series of annual concerts and oversaw the Deiro Collection for materials pertaining to the Deiro Brothers who introduced the piano-accordion to the United States in the early twentieth century.

History of the Donor

Allan W. Atlas is a Distinguished Professor of Music at the Graduate Center, where he is Director of *The Center for the Study of Free-Reed Instruments*. He is also the published author of “Renaissance Music: music in Western Europe 1400-1600” (1998).

Description

The majority of the collection is comprised of books and periodicals relating to Free-Reed Instruments. The rest of the collection includes photocopies or research materials, diagrams, and notes.

Arrangement

This collection is arranged into # series: Series I: Books ; Series II: Serials; Series III: Audio; Series IV: International Concertina Association Papers; Series V: Concertina Research Materials.

Series I: Books – 1947-2009. The books are comprised of 31 volumes pertaining to free-reed instruments; particularly the accordion and concertina. Most of the collection is published in English, but includes publications in French, Swedish, Finnish, German, Spanish, and Russian. The series has been included in the Mina Rees library stacks for circulation. A complete list of the books is included in Box 1.

Series II: International Concertina Association Papers 1983-1999. Includes newsletters, notes, library list, & membership list.
