## 9/11 Memorial Exhibit

During the month of September 2004 the Ursula C. Schwerin Library is marking the third anniversary of 9/11 by presenting "Remembering September 11", an exhibit on the tragic attack on America three years ago.

Highlights of the display are 2 projects from City Tech students. In one endeavor, students from [Prof. Robert Holden's Advertising Design and Graphic Arts class](#) created posters. These were done in September 2001, shortly after the events of 9/11. Also on view are architectural models relating to the rebuilding of Ground Zero, from [Architectural Technology](#) students taught by [Prof. Jill Bouratoglou](#); some of these models were previously displayed in the City Tech Library.

The exhibit also includes books, pamphlets and other materials dealing with the attacks on the World Trade Center and the Pentagon. The display can be viewed in the large display case outside the Library during the hours when the College is open.
