H O S T O S R A D I O L O G Y S T U D E N T S T O M A K E M E D I C A L P R E S E N T A T I O N

Students and faculty participating in the radiologic technology program at Hostos Community College will present a technical seminar demonstrating many of the techniques they have mastered in the course of their studies at Hostos at 1:00 p.m. on May 20 at the Concourse Campus, 475 Grand Concourse, Bronx, New York.

The medical presentation has been developed by the students in conjunction with their clinical practice at Bronx-Lebanon Hospital, Hospital for Special Surgery, Lenox Hill Hospital, and Beth Israel Medical Center.

Featured at the presentation will be a film depicting the history of radiography shown by representatives of the 3M company. Mr. Howard Goldman, director of the Bureau of X-ray Technology of the State Department of Health in Albany, will lecture on state licensing. Students will demonstrate radiographic techniques of scoliosis, arthrography, the stomach, and the urinary system.

Administrators of the radiology departments of the hospitals participating in the Hostos radiology technology program are expected to attend.
