New York: City of Books

December 4, 2006-January 31, 2007

Please stop by the College Library before January 31, 2007 to view *New York: City of Books*, a project by AD530 Advanced Photography Studio, taught by Professor Robin Michals (ADGA). At City Tech, one of our greatest resources is the text of New York City. It is the 'City of Books' in many senses: as a center of publishing, as the site for many works of literature and as a gathering place of expertise in many disciplines. For this project, each student chose a location to photograph and then worked with Professor Anne Leonard (Library) to find a book that would relate to the selected site. The two images were composited together to create a seamless illusion of huge, towering books in the city. This assignment was inspired by a book festival poster assignment in Katrin Eismann's *Photoshop Masking and Compositing* as well as the faculty development project *Retentions and Transfigurations: The Technological Evolution and Social History of Five New York City Neighborhoods*.
