Such approval is to be granted upon receipt of official transcripts (or grades), assuming all other requirements for the degree have been met. The awarding of the degree to those students in these categories (FWE - who did not satisfy all other degree requirements and GM - grade missing) is subject to action of the Executive Committee of Committee on Academic Standing. (The names of same said students to be reported to the Committee on Academic Standing).

CARRIED: Unanimously

- 3) MOTION: "L" & "B" Motion - To permit the Registrar to approve, in the name of the Committee on Academic Standing, the award of degrees to those students who have Library and Business office obligations outstanding at this time but are subsequently certified as satisfied by the Librarian and/or Business Officer -- the names of these students to be reported to the Committee on Academic Standing.

- 4) MOTION: To award A.A. Degree and A.A.S. Degree as applicable to "X" candidates who have completed all requirements for their respective curricula indicating an index of 2.00 or higher.


