"Rumble," a Broadway-style play which will be directed, managed, and choreographed by students from Hostos Community College, will be presented on December 18 at 3:30 p.m. at J.H.S. 145 at 120th Street and First Avenue. A second performance will be given on December 20 at 2:00 p.m. Admission for students is \$.50 and \$1.00 for non-students.

The Hostos students who will present the play are all enrolled in Play Production II, a module offered by Prof. David Barrie at the College. They include Brunhilda Ruiz, director; Eric Harrigan, stage manager; Leon Oliver, set designer; Sharon Young, costume designer; Frederica Bruey, properties and make-up; and Josie Ramirez, choreographer.

Performers in the play number 30 to 35 young people between the ages of 11 and 13. "Rumble," which depicts a neighborhood struggle between the "Sharks" and the "Jets," stars Mary Rin as Maria, Eddie Calderon as Bernardo, Elizabeth Ramos as Anita, Norberto Apellanez as Chino, Willie Losada as Tony, and Thomas Cortez as Riff.

Bruny Ruiz, the play's director and a student at Hostos, says that many of the talented young performers plan to try out for admission to New York City's High School of Performing Arts.
