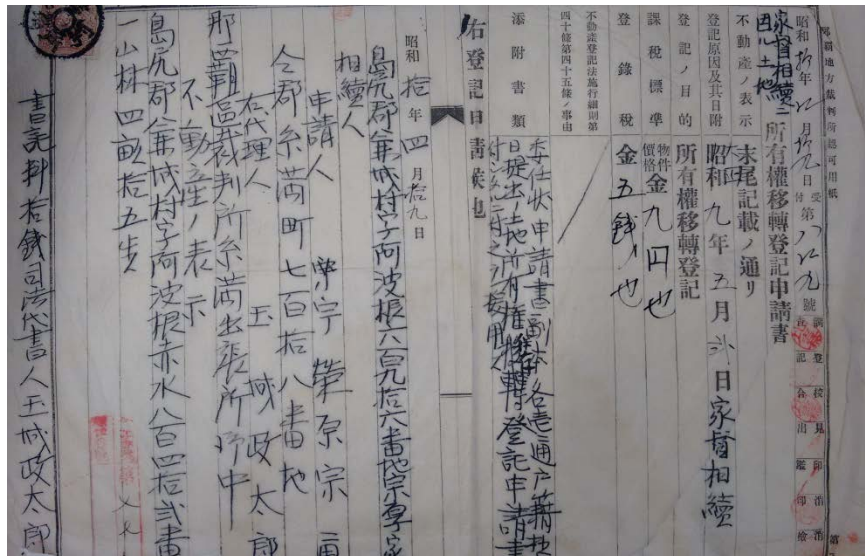

Historical Note

The Brooklyn Archives and Special Collections received a collection of Local History (accession #: 89-003) from St. Francis College, in 1988, which was created by James A. Kelly, Brooklyn's first borough historian.

Besides history of Brooklyn, Kelly also collected diverse materials based on his interests and on what was given to him. This small collection of World War II Memorabilia is one example. It used to be a subseries in the Local History Collection, but it was decided that it would be more appropriate for it to constitute its own collection. This decision was based on two factors: first, this memorabilia does not relate to the history of Brooklyn, and second, it would facilitate access to researchers interested in World War II.

Scope and Content Note

The collection World War II Memorabilia contains various materials related to the war, from different countries: Japan, France, the Netherlands, Italy, and Germany. It includes photographs, manuscripts, illustrations, post cards, flyers, and cigarette cards.
