

Parents to See Fruits Of Children's Labor

College President Dr. Harry D. Gideonse, will welcome the parents of B.C. students who worked on the farm labor project at Morrisville, N. Y. at an informal program in Boylan Hall on Sunday, Dec. 5.

The program will consist of brief talks by Dr. Malcolm B. Gailbreath, director of the Technical and Agricultural Institute in Morrisville, and Prof. Ralph C. Benedict, who was director of the college project. The parents will also see

motion pictures of the activities that their sons and daughters engaged in during the summer.

The project has served as the experimental basis upon which further extension of similar food production projects for city students may be planned. It has also set a possible pattern for postwar educational planning which the state might adopt as a program to promote more and more collaboration between urban and rural communities.
