"J" Grade--The Cooperative Education Internship Program (continued from May 26 meeting)

Prof. Krieger spoke to the CAS concerning the effect of the "J" grade on the Cooperative Education Internship Program.

**MOTION:** In light of the special requirements of the Cooperative Education Program, students enrolled in off-campus employment courses, which must meet the criteria of the cooperating employer, may only be granted a J or H with the approval of the program coordinator.

PASSED 11-0-1

This special meeting was called for the purpose of granting degrees to June, 1971 candidates for graduation. Therefore, consideration of candidates for the degree, including individual discussion of doubtful cases, constituted the remainder of the agenda.

Candidates for degree - June, 1971

1. A motion was made that the Registrar be permitted to approve, in the name of the CAS, the award of degrees to those students whose records are not complete at this time as a result of registration at other colleges from which official transcripts have not been received to date, or who are missing grades. Such approval is to be granted upon receipt of official transcripts (or grades), assuming all other requirements for the degree have been met. The awarding of the degree to those students in this category (FWE) who did not satisfy all other degree requirements is subject to action of the Executive Committee of the CAS. (Names to be reported subsequently to CAS).

PASSED: unanimously

2. A motion was made to permit the Registrar to approve, in the name of the CAS the award of degrees to those students who have Library and Business Office obligations outstanding at this time, but are subsequently certified as "clear" by the Librarian or Business Officer. (Names to be reported subsequently to CAS).

PASSED: unanimously

3. A motion to award the A.A. Degree to 125 candidates in their respective curricula:

- 90 in Liberal Arts and Sciences
- 22 in Engineering Science
- 9 in Business Administration
- 2 in Business Teaching, Accounting
- 2 in Business Teaching, Secretarial Studies

who have completed all requirements for the degree, including a cumulative Index of 2.00 or higher, was made.

4. A motion to award the A.S. degree to 12 candidates in Liberal Arts and Sciences who have completed all requirements for the degree, including a cumulative Index of 2.00 or higher, was made.
