I. Minutes of the Meeting of January 5, 1972

II. Summary of Degrees Granted January 1961 to August 1971

The report of Summary of Degrees Granted January 1961 to August 1971 from the Office of the Registrar and Admissions Officer dated January 20, 1972, was received.

III. Candidates for Degrees, January 1972

A. 1. MOTION: To permit the Registrar to approve, in the name of the CAS, the award of degrees to those students whose records are not complete at this time as a result of registration at other colleges from which official transcripts have not been received to date, or who are missing grades. Such approval is to be granted upon receipt of official transcripts (or grades), assuming all other requirements for the degree have been met. The awarding of the degree to those students in this category (FWE) who did not satisfy all other degree requirements is subject to action of the Executive Committee of the CAS. (Names to be reported subsequently to CAS)

MOTION: To permit the Registrar to approve, in the name of the CAS, the award of degrees to those students who have Library and/or Business Office obligations outstanding at this time but are subsequently certified as "clear" by the Librarian or Business Officer. (Names to be reported subsequently to CAS)

B. 1. MOTION: To award the Associate in Arts degree to 131 candidates who have completed all the requirements for the degree in their respective curriculums, including an index of 2.00 or higher.
