

Minutes of the Faculty-Student Committee
on the Work-Study Project for 1944

April 23, 1944

A meeting of the Faculty-Student Committee on the Morrisville Work-Study Project for 1944 was called to order by the Chairman at 4:30 o'clock, Friday, April 23, 1944.

The meeting was given over to a consideration of the Report of the Campus Activities subcommittee. (Report dated, April 13, 1944)

The adoption of the Report was moved, seconded, and carried with the following amendments:

1. that section 2 of the division dealing with Student Government be rephrased so as to provide for the election of a student work representative and several assistants.
2. That section 3 of the division dealing with Off-Campus Travelling include the proviso that students travel in the environs of Morrisville in the company of at least one other person.

In the course of the discussion it was suggested that the Campus Activities subcommittee be ^{recommended} ~~recommended~~ to consider and report upon the matter of student enforcement of those regulations which come within the scope of campus activities as defined in this Report.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:00 o'clock.
