

SUIT TO BAR PURCHASE OF COLLEGE SITE ENDS

Withdrawal by the Community Councils Will Release PWA Funds to City.

The Community Councils of New York withdrew yesterday its suit to prevent the city from buying the Wood-Harmon site in Flatbush as the location for the new Brooklyn College, thus removing the danger that the city might not be able to collect the \$5,500,000 grant of FWA funds to aid in the construction of five buildings.

As soon as the suit was withdrawn Corporation Counsel Windels notified the Federal authorities in Washington that the barrier to the payment of the City College fund had been removed by the Community Councils.

The action of the plaintiff in withdrawing the injunction suit relieved Supreme Court Justice Callahan from the necessity of passing on the Corporation Counsel's application to throw the case out of court.

The city had until yesterday to give notice that no litigation was pending.
