Instructions for Registration, and Start of Class Meetings: June 16, 1943.

Note: Some of the information below was given at the meeting on June 1; some is new and additional. Check every item, and follow carefully.

Applications: A few more applications can be accepted with the understanding that they may be put on a waiting list. Apply at Room 2215 Boylan, Placement Office.

Registration: Wednesday, June 16.

Classes Begin: Thursday, June 17: 9:00 - 11:30 A.M.

First Assembly: Thursday, June 17: 12:00 Noon.

M-Day: Mobilize, and Move to Morrisville, Monday, June 28. (A few days earlier, if weather and crops permit).

Registration Procedure:

1. Prior to June 16, secure a money-order for \$5.00 (Room deposit) from your local Post Office, payable to the New York State Agricultural Institute, Morrisville, N.Y.
2. Bring this with you Wednesday morning, and show as requested. You will be given an enclosure form to mail with it.
3. Call at the Bursar's Office (Room 1155-Boylan) and pay the Library fee of \$1.00. This fee receipt must be presented for registration.
4. As soon as you have paid your Library fee, step across the hall to Rm 1154 Boylan for the following:
  - a. enclosure to accompany your room deposit; (bring a stamped envelope to mail immediately to Morrisville.)
  - b. specific course assignment.
5. 1:00 PM (same day) - report promptly to the Little Theater (Rm 4200 Boylan) A representative of the Registrar's Office will be present to complete your registration.
6. Those who register for one of the laboratory courses will then return to the Bursar's Office to pay their laboratory fees. Laboratory receipts must be presented at the first class session, the next day.  
(Geology 1: \$2.00; Biology 7: \$4.00.)

Dormitory Assignments, and definite arrangements about room mates will be taken up after classes have started.
