- III. Student Appeals
 - A. Professor Barnette distributed minutes of the Subcommittee on Student Appeals dated November 5, 1986
 - B. Motion was made to sustain the recommendations of the subcommittee. Action was unanimously carried 16-0-0
- IV. Old Business
 - A. Prof. Sharp recommended that a statement be given out with grade reports explaining probation and suspension
 - B. Prof. Sharp discussed the fact that many students are not aware that they are on probation until they are far into the next semester
 - C. Recommendations
 1. Explanation of codes on grade report to students
 2. Explanation of the implications of suspension
 3. Drafting a recommendation to address the problem (Prof. Barnette and Prof. Sharp)
- V. Establishment of a Sunshine Committee - Prof. R. Tate will collect \$5.00 from each committee member. Money left over in the fund at the end of the semester will be used for the end of semester luncheon in June
- VI. New Business
 - A. Prof. O'Sullivan explained that traditionally Mathematics 21 is earmarked for transfer students and Mathematics 12 is for career students
 - B. Recently, there seems to be suggestions on campus deviating from this pattern
