I. Minutes

- A. Motion: To approve the minutes of October 11, 1989, with the following corrections: (1) Under IV. A., New Business, the motion was approved 12-0-0 instead of 11-0-0. (2) Minutes of Subcommittee on Student Appeals, dated Wednesday, October 4, 1989: pages 2, 4, and 6 are missing. A complete set of minutes will be appended to the minutes of October 25, 1989. Approved 12-0-3.
- B. Minutes of meeting of June 8, 1989: Approved 9-0-6.
- C. Minutes of meeting of May 10, 1989: Approved 7-0-8.

II. Communications

- A. Profs. J. Skurdenis and I. Zimmerman communicated that they could not attend today's meeting.

III. Student Appeals

- A. Omnibus motion: To sustain the recommendations of the CAS Subcommittee on Student Appeals in its minutes of October 18, 1989, with the exception of Aaron Williams. Approved unanimously.
- B. Motion: To deny appeal of Aaron Williams, with the recommendation that he be advised to reappeal pending the results of his performance this semester. Defeated 5-8-1.
- C. Motion: To sustain the recommendation of the CAS Subcommittee on Student Appeals in the case of Aaron Williams. Approved 12-2-1.

IV. Subcommittee on Student Appeals

Prof. Barnette will chair the next meeting of the Subcommittee at 2 p.m., Wednesday, November 15, Loew Hall 317. Profs. Greenfield, Morales, and Todaro agreed to attend.

V. Election of Recording Secretary

The Executive Secretary cast one ballot in the name of the Committee for Phyllis Read to act as Recording Secretary for the academic year 1989-1990.

VI. August 1989 candidates for graduation:

- A. "FWE" motion: To permit the Registrar to approve, in the name of the CAS, the awarding of degrees to those students whose records are not complete at this time as a result of registration at other colleges from which official transcripts have not been received to date, or who are missing grades. Such approval is to be granted upon receipt of official transcripts (or grades), assuming all other requirements for the degree have been met. The awarding of the degree to those students in this category (FWE) who did not satisfy all other degree requirements is subject to action of the Executive Committee of the CAS. (Names to be reported subsequently to CAS.) Approved 14-0-1.
- B. "L" and "B" motion: To permit the Registrar to approve, in the name of the CAS, the awarding of degrees to those students who have Library and Business Office obligations outstanding at this time but are subsequently certified as "clear" by the Librarian or Business Officer. (Names to be reported subsequently to CAS.) Approved 14-0-1.
- C. Motion: To award the AA, AAS, AS, and certificates to all candidates who have met the requirements of their respective curricula, with the exception of doubtful cases and Ana Albaladejo. Approved 14-0-0.
- D. Doubtful Cases
 - 1. Motion: To award by special action a degree in Business Administration to Stephen Moore. Approved 14-0-1.
 - 2. Motion: To award by special action a degree in Liberal Arts to Veronica Peterkin. Approved unanimously.

3. Motion: To award a degree in Secretarial Studies to Ana Albaladejo. Approved unanimously.

VII. New Business

- A. Suspension rules: The Registrar will check on suspensions regarding (1) guaranteed student loan defaults, and (2) the six-month forgiveness policy, and report back to CAS.
- B. Abs-Inc regulations: Mr. Erdsneker will convene the Subcommittee on Abs-Inc regulations. Prof. L. DeAcztis and J. Hamell are to serve on that committee.
