I. Minutes

Motion: That the Secretary of the CAS send a letter to the Dean of Academic Affairs indicating the Committee's displeasure that students were allowed to misrepresent the current Dean's List Regulations at the recent Dean's List Reception without response from the Committee. The Committee regrets that its representative was denied the opportunity to clarify the matter before the audience at the reception, especially since upon investigation it was determined that the two students who spoke on the matter were misinformed. Approved 13-0-2.
