- A. "FWE" and "GM" motion: To permit the Registrar to approve, in the name of the CAS, the awarding of degrees to those students whose records are not complete at this time as a result of registration at other colleges from which official transcripts have not been received to date, or who are missing grades. Such approval is to be granted upon receipt of official transcripts (or grades), assuming all other requirements for the degree have been met. The awarding of the degree to those students in this


category (FWE) who do not satisfy all other degree requirements is subject to action of the Executive Committee of the CAS. (Names to be reported subsequently to CAS.) Approved unanimously.

- B. "L" and "B" motion: To permit the Registrar to approve, in the name of the CAS, the awarding of degrees to those students who have library and business office obligations outstanding at this time but are subsequently certified as "clear" by the Librarian or Business Officer. (Names to be reported subsequently to CAS.) Approved unanimously.
- C. Motion: To empower the Registrar to award the degree to all students who have the credit requirements for their respective degrees. Approved unanimously.
- D. Motion: To deny, with Clause A, the awarding of the degree to Lenet O'Bryan. Approved 14-0-1.
- E. Motion: To award, by special action, the degree to Maritza Taylee. Approved unanimously.
- F. Motion: To award, by special action, the degree to Rhonda London. Approved 9-3-3.
- G. Motion: To award, by special action, the degree to Donna Richards. Approved unanimously.
- H. Motion: To award, by special action, the degree to Bobby Seuraj. Approved unanimously.
