Executive Session

In the absence of a quorum, the committee members went into executive session.

Student Appeals

- A. Omnibus motion: To sustain the recommendations of the Subcommittee on Student Appeals in its minutes of May 13, 1992. Approved unanimously.
- B. Individual Student Cases--Executive Committee
Members of the CAS considered each of the 13 individual cases presented by Prof. Barnette, representing the Executive Committee.
Motion: To sustain the recommendations of the Executive Committee in all 13 student appeal cases.
Approved 11-0-1.

Full Committee Session

I. Minutes

Motion: To approve the minutes of May 13, 1992.

II. Communications

- A. Prof. J. Morales, A. Resto, and J. Skurdenis communicated that they could not attend today's meeting.
- B. Prof. Hayde announced that the CAS will probably meet on a weekly basis during the early part of the fall, 1992 semester.

III. Graduation Business

- A. No doubtful cases in nursing or engineering.
- B. Doubtful cases not ready today will be considered in Executive Committee Session.
- C. The following *pro forma* motions were made:
 1. To empower the Registrar to award the degree to all students who have the credit requirements for their respective degrees with a cumulative index of 2.0 or higher.
 2. "FWE" and "GM": To permit the Registrar to

approve, in the name of the CAS, the awarding of degrees to those students whose records are not complete at this time as a result of registration at other colleges from which official transcripts have not been received to date, or who are missing grades. Such approval is to be granted upon receipt of official transcripts (or grades), assuming all other requirements for the degree have been met. The awarding of the degree to those students in this category (FWE) who did not satisfy all other degree requirements is subject to action of the Executive committee of the CAS. (Names to be reported subsequently to CAS.)

3. "L" and "B": To permit the Registrar to approve, in the name of the CAS, the awarding of degrees to those students who have Library and Business Office obligations outstanding at this time but are subsequently certified as "clear" by the Librarian or Business Officer. (Names to be reported subsequently to CAS.)
In accordance with the usual procedure, those candidates whose cumulative indexes are below 1.95 will not be brought up for individual consideration.

Motions 1, 2, and 3 approved unanimously.

4. A.A., A.S., and A.A.S. degree motion: To allow the Registrar to
(a) award the A.A. degree to "X" candidates in... who have completed all the requirements for their respective curriculums, including an index of 2.00 or higher;
(b) award the A.S. degree...
(c) award the A.A.S. degree to "X" candidates who have completed all the requirements for the degree in their respective curricula...including an index of 2.00 or higher.
Motion approved unanimously.

IV. Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at twelve noon.
