VI. Criteria for Admission Into the Clinical Nursing Sequence

The Nursing Department offered the following amendment to the criteria for admission into the clinical nursing sequence:

To be eligible for admission into the clinical nursing sequence, applicants must achieve (1) at least a C+ grade in both Biology 23 and Pharmacology 10; and (2) a satisfactory score (40th percentile) on the National League for Nursing Pre-Admission Examination RN test.

(A pre-nursing sequence average of 2.5 will continue to be the minimal acceptable level determining eligibility.)

There being no objections, the amendment carried.
