IV. Graduation Business

- A. FWE and GM Motion: To permit the Registrar to approve, in the name of the CAS, the awarding of degrees to those students whose records are not complete at this time as a result of registration at other colleges from which official transcripts have not been received to date, or who are missing grades. Such approval is to be granted upon receipt of official transcripts (or grades), assuming all other requirements for the degree have been met. The awarding of the degree to those students in this category (FWE) who did not satisfy all other degree requirements is subject to action of the Executive Committee of the CAS. (Names are to be reported subsequently to the CAS.) Approved unanimously.
- B. L&B Motion: To permit the Registrar to approve, in the name of the CAS, the awarding of degrees to those students who have Library and Business Office obligations outstanding at this time but are subsequently certified as "clear" by the Librarian or Bursar. (Names are to be reported subsequently to the CAS.) Approved unanimously.
- C. Motion to award A.A. Degree, A.S. Degree, A.A.S. Degree and Certificates to "X" candidates in ... who have completed all of the requirements for their respective curriculums, including an index of 2.00 or higher. Approved unanimously.
- D. Motion: To award posthumously, by special action, the degree to Ms. Lisa Luciano, who met all the degree requirements as of January, 1996. The degree is to be given to Ms. Luciano's family. Approved unanimously.
