IV. **ILLiad 9.1**: Has anyone received an update? It appears to be ready for release at some point in November 2019 (www.atlas-sys.com/illiad-roadmap)

Tina Perez attended a recent webinar and explained that there are quite a few changes with 9.1--good changes. New improvements. Cleaner and nicer pages, however, overall, a lot of bugs. That's why they keep postponing its launch. Not a lot of prep will be required. With the changeover into Alma, however, a lot of things will change. An Alma webinar will be available online. As soon as Tina gets it she will distribute.

V. Guest speaker:

Tina Perez, Serials and Document Delivery Services Manager SUNY Optometry: "Resource Sharing in Alma"

Tina provided an insightful and detailed overview of the changes to expect with Alma. She mentioned issues with printing and her email workaround using Thunderbird and Outlook. She warned us about the different terms used in Alma, issues with cataloging and non-circulating items circulating, using XML to customize notifications, issues with authentication (LDAP, EZ Proxy, etc..), automatic overdue messages needing to be turned off in ILLiad, and ILLiad connecting to Alma but not vice versa particularly with renewal requests. She mentioned that there are addons that can help with connecting Alma and ILLiad. Tina pointed out that the ILLiad-Alma integration is limited to checking out and checking in books for borrowing, but the benefit of this integration is that patrons can see all the books they've checked out in one place. All are welcome to visit Tina at SUNY Optometry in Manhattan to see ALMA in action.
