

3. Minutes. The minutes of the February 19 meeting were approved as read.
4. Correspondence: CUNY Freshman Skills Assessment Program, Consultants' Reports on Math and English FSAP, attached.
5. Distribution. Entry-level course requirements in basic skills from five more departments were received and distributed.

A discussion ensued on what happens in the registration process: Entry requirements are not always observed and students end up in courses they are not prepared for. A "restricted registration" system was set up in the computer in the Spring '90 registration for many courses. Is it possible to observe all entry-level requirements and still give full programs to students, satisfying TAP requirements, etc. Freshmen, registering in the latter days of the registration period, are often blocked out of the very courses they need. Are more non-pre-requisite courses needed? More articulation is needed.
6. New Curriculum Proposal -- Nuclear Medicine Technology.
Presented by Prof. D. Sacher and Dr. J. Prince, Physics. No action possible at this meeting.
7. New Course Proposal -- Basic Musicianship.
Presented by J. D'Angelo, Music and Art. No action possible.
