COURSE DESCRIPTION: Methods and Materials for Teaching Language Arts in a Bilingual Program.

A competency based course enabling students to acquire the knowledge and skills to teach in a bilingual program.

Competencies: Understanding how children acquire and develop language; knowledge of psychological principles underlying current methods in second language teaching; knowledge of language arts literature in the field of bilingual education; knowledge of second language teaching materials and techniques, ability to teach oral and other language development skills; and the ability to apply observation and analysis skills to second language learning situations.

Prerequisites: RDL 02, ENG 13; EDU 16 or EDU 17; corequisites: literacy at the 13 level, e.g. SPN 13, FR 13, ITAL 13, or permission from the department. 3 REC 3 CREDIT.
