3. MINUTES

4. CORRESPONDENCE
  - A. Letter from Dr. Shenkman informing the Curriculum Committee that the course "Methods and Materials for Teaching Language Arts in a Bilingual Program" has been accepted for transferability by CUNY.
  - B. Two letters from Prof. Oleg M. Rodzianko (see attached).
    1. Change in course titles in the Electrical Technology. Approved unanimously.
    2. Change in requisites for several Electrical Technology courses. This item was added to the agenda for discussion.
  - C. Dr. J. Ryan reported that the B.C.C. Senate approved the Curriculum Committee report for the preceding five meetings.
  - D. Dr. J. Ryan informed the Curriculum Committee that the Governance Plan has been changed to include department representation on the Curriculum Committee.
5. Item number 3 on the agenda of changing the remedial sequence in Mathematics for MLT was postponed for further clarification.
6. Placement of the following new items on the agenda:
  1. New course - History of the Ancient World.
  2. Change in the pre-requisites in the existing courses: MUS 10, 11 & 12 and ART 10, 11, 12.
  3. Change in requisites for Electrical Technology courses.
7. New Liberal Arts option in International Studies was introduced by Dr. A. Galub. Questions were asked to which replies will be made at the next meeting.

8. Change in existing course: D.C. Circuit Analysis - ELC 11  
Prof. P. Berger passed out material and took questions to be answered next week.
9. New Course Proposal: History of the Ancient World. Dr. J. Ryan passed out material and took questions, to be answered next week.
10. Change in requisites for Electrical Technology courses. Prof. P. Berger passed out materials and took questions.
11. Change in existing co-requisites for Art and Music 10, 11, and 12. Amended proposal was passed out to change the current co-requisites for Art and Music 10, 11, 12 from ENG 02 or RDL 02 to RDL 01 and ENG 01. Amended proposal was accepted as an action item (18 - 0 - 1). Prof. J. D'Angelo asked to move this item to the agenda for action next week.
