Orientation & Career Development for Freshmen - 1 Rec. 0 Cr.\*

\*Program weight of 1 hour but not creditable towards a Degree.

This course will enable student to develop basic college survival skills in the areas of Academic life, setting career goals, time management, analysis of classroom behavior, assessment of instructor demands and utilization of library and other college resources. Emphasis will be placed upon the students' understanding of the Academic environment and its demands on their developing successful coping and achievement behavior.

Motion passed: 17-1-0.


