III. The Minutes of December 5 were approved.

IV. Old Business

A. Prof. Schwartz (H-P.E.) distributed a report prepared by his department, on the need to include a course in Health and Physical Education in the A.A.S. Curricula.

B. Prof. Schwartz (H-P.E.) moved the postponement of any consideration of the sub-committee report on Core Courses in the A.A.S. Programs until the February 27 meeting. The motion passed by a show of hands.

C. Estelle Kissel (Music & Art) moved the adoption of the following changes in the Computer Graphics Curriculum: Data 34 to replace Key 10; Eng. 12 to replace Eng. 14,15 and 16; the proposed new course "Commercial Illustration" to replace CMT 11.

D. Prof. Lal (Physics) proposed the approval of the addition of Soc. 11 to the Core requirements for the Engineering Sciences Curriculum and the correction of the typo omission of Math 35 to the Core requirements.

- E. Prof. Shopkow (Business) moved to table the adoption of these changes until Feb. 27. This was approved unanimously by a show of hands.
