MINUTES OF COMMITTEE ON INSTRUCTION - DECEMBER 7, 1971

Dr. Berger, the Chairman, opened the meeting at 2:30 p.m. The first item was the approval of the minutes of the last meeting.

Then the Chairman circulated a letter from Dr. Meng on the subject of evaluation of the teaching faculty by students. Another 13-page set of material on "Evaluating Teacher Effectiveness", by Codi and Neville, ERIC Clearing House on Higher Education dated September, 1971 will be reproduced for members of the committee for their careful perusal, said the Chairman.

Prof. Hirschfield reported on his subcommittee on Questionnaire and Accountability. It was difficult to reach the interested members of the Subcommittee by phone and it was slow by mail, so that only two persons (Dr. Eagle and Prof. Hirschfield) met on November 30.

Dr. Berger then gave out copies of his old questionnaire. Someone suggested that an instructor might like to select some of the questions from that list for the students to answer.

Prof. Gore reported that the Math Department had prepared a questionnaire with a rating scale of 1 to 4 on a single page.

Prof. Lessard said he had a questionnaire with only 20 questions that will add up to a score of exactly 100 points.

Prof. Canty reported on The Media Freak's sponsoring of a TV Workshop a week from today.

Prof. Gorman reported on Film Loops and demonstrated 2 such loops.

The meeting adjourned at 4 p.m.
