- I. Chairman James Ryan called the meeting to order at 2:40 P.M.
- II. The minutes of the November 15, 1994 meeting were approved unanimously after being amended to show the vote in Items IIIB and IVB as follows:

- III. OLD BUSINESS
 - A. Professor Geraldine Diallo responded to questions raised at the last meeting of the committee in reference to the proposed new course, "The Americas: Cultures in Comparison and Contrast" (Geography 20). Additional discussion followed on various aspects of the course. Action on the proposal is possible at the next meeting.
- IV. NEW BUSINESS
 - A. Professor Charlotte Honda, Director of the Bronx Educational Alliance - Articulation Center for Transferring Students, made a presentation on BCC / Lehman College course articulation. She presented articulation/ transfer charts which showed both Lehman College degree requirements and BCC course equivalents (see attached). The charts, prepared by Prof. Honda, simplify articulation information for students who are transferring to Lehman. Prof. Honda indicated that articulation charts will be also be prepared for students transferring to City College and Hunter College.
 - B. Professor Estelle Kissel presented a proposal for a new course, "Computer Music Sequencing" (Music 20). This experimental course is a continuation and expansion of the topics and concepts taught in "Creative Computer Music" (Music 14) and is scheduled to run in the Spring semester of 1995.
 - C. Professor James Ryan announced that the Business Department has requested a postponement of their presentation to the next committee meeting (Agenda item. IVB)
