2. Dr. Ryan convened the meeting at 2:45 P.M.

3. Minutes

The February 22nd meeting was inaccurately recorded as occurring on February 21st. The last line on page 19, 3 D. was altered to now read, Because the committee did not consider this a substantive change, the update of the course description was approved viva voce. As amended, the minutes of the February 22, 1994 meeting were approved unanimously.

Corrections were made to the minutes from March 8, 1994. On page 24 in the eighth line from the top, the typo curricular should be corrected to curricular. Re item 5. A., pages 25-31 should be deleted and the description of Medical Assistant Externship (Bio 93) expanded to include 160 hours of externship, 2 cr. As amended, these minutes were approved.

A. Dr. Ryan welcomed Prof. Sharon Clarke from the Physics Department as a new member of the Curriculum Committee.

- B. Dr. Ryan read his own request from the History Department to change the course title of History 14 from Europe in the Middle Ages to Medieval History to more accurately reflect the scope and content of this course. Since this was a minor change, the committee unanimously approved his request viva voce.
 - C. Dean Fuller announced that the Department of Special Educational Services wishes to change its name to Department of Education and Academic Skills.
5. Old Business
- A. The proposal for an A.S. degree program in Mathematics with four attendant new courses (Linear Algebra, 4 lect., 4 cr., Vector Analysis, 4 lect., 4 cr., Abstract Algebra, 4 lect., 4 cr., and Advanced Calculus, 4 lect., 4 cr.) was passed: 15-0-1.
 - B. Prof. Henry Frisz responded to the committee's questions concerning the proposed truck/bus and aviation options in the Automotive AAS curriculum.
 - C. Dr. Arthur Galub answered questions concerning the proposed new course, State and Local Government.
