- II Approval of Minutes:

- III Correspondence, reports, announcements:
(1) Chairperson Ryan reported on a memo sent to VP Keizs and himself from Dr. Berger (Chairperson Department of Social Sciences) regarding the modern language requirement in the Human Services curriculum.
- IV Old Business:
(1) Proposed new experimental course:
Introduction to Geographic Information Systems
Department of History

V New Business:

- (1) Changes in pre and co-requisites for an existing course
CMS 11 – Fundamentals of Interpersonal Communication
Department of Communication Arts & Sciences
The Department of Communication Arts & Sciences proposed a change in the pre and co-requisites for CMS 11. The current requirements are co-requisites of ENG 02 or RDL 02. The proposal adds prerequisites of ENG 01 and RDL 01. Questions were asked of the department representative (Dr. Gonsler – Department Chairperson). Answers are to be provided at the next committee meeting. No committee action possible.
- (2) Change in Course Title:
PEA 51 – Stress Management & Wellness
Department of Health, Physical Education and Wellness
The Department of Health, Physical Education and Wellness proposed a change in the title of PEA 51 from Stress Management & Wellness to Stress Management. The Committee voted unanimously to waive the three meeting rule and vote on this as a routine item. A motion to approve the change in course title passed unanimously.
