
- I Chairperson Ryan called the meeting to order at 2:10pm.
- II Approval of Minutes:
 - (1) The minutes of 11/7/00 were approved unanimously.
- III Correspondence, reports, announcements:
 - (1) Chairperson Ryan sent a memo to Dr. Berger (Chairperson Department of Social Sciences) replying to her memo regarding the modern language requirement in the Human Services curriculum.
 - (2) The South Hall Conference Room will not be available for our next scheduled meeting (12/5/2000). The Committee will meet in the President's Conference Room instead.
 - (3) Dean Fuller informed the Committee that the next meeting will be the last chance to present any new items to the Curriculum Committee and be able to have it passed by the June 2000 CUNY Board meeting.

Dr. Montenegro (Department of Physics & Technology representative and Subcommittee Chairperson) reported on the Subcommittee's meetings this semester. Topics discussed included a current grant supporting the Basic Skills Institute and pending support by the Subcommittee.

- (2) Report from the Subcommittee on Course Evaluation:
Dr. Gonsher (Department of Communications Arts & Sciences representative and Subcommittee Chairperson) reported on the Subcommittee's meetings this semester. The matter of Writing Enhanced courses was discussed. Dr. Gonsher will soon send a memo to all Department Chairs delineating what must be included in Writing Enhanced courses.
- (3) Proposed new experimental course:
Introduction to Geographic Information Systems
Department of History
A motion to add a new course entitled Introduction to Geographic Information Systems passed by a vote of 19-1-1.
- (4) Proposed change in an existing curriculum:
Increase in allowable Mathematics courses-
Liberal Arts AA Transfer Curriculum
A motion to change the existing Liberal Arts AA Transfer Curriculum passed by a vote of 15-6-0.
- (5) Changes in pre and co-requisites for an existing course

Department of Communication Arts & Sciences
