III. Reports, Announcements

- A. A copy of a memorandum to the registrar regarding experimental courses advisement was distributed. In that connection, departments were requested to notify the Office of Academic Affairs when such courses were offered, paying special attention to the two-year limit in offering such courses prior to securing permanent status through the Curriculum Committee.  
B. The Dept. of Student Development suggests the policy of inclusion of OCD 01 as a component of all block programs.

IV. Old Business

- A. An experimental course in Pharmacology (PHM 20) (Nursing) was approved 15-1-0. (See attached, p. 92)  
B. A letter of intent outlining a proposed A.S. Degree Program in Health and Exercise Science, including five specialized curricula and four attendant new courses, was distributed by the Dept. of Health, Physical Education, and Wellness, and approved 14-0-2.  
C. Professor Gonsher answered questions regarding the experimental course CMS 14.

V. New Business

A. Professor Kanuck distributed materials relating to changes in prerequisites and corequisites for BIO 50. It was noted that at a previous meeting similar changes were approved for other courses in the Department of Biology and MLT. Thus, the requirement for three meetings was dispensed with and the changes approved 17-0-0. (See attached, p. 43 )
