Summary Statement of Proposal:

A. Objectives:

- (1) To train disadvantaged minority group youth and adults for entry level positions now closed to them.
- (2) To motivate disadvantaged, underprepared persons to pursue career preparation studies in the computer science field

B. Time Period:

January 1, 1972 to June 30, 1972

C. Methods:

Trainees will be enrolled in regularly scheduled day or evening classes at Bronx Community College. They will be required to complete a minimum of 16 credits in basic computer systems and operations plus 6 credits in mathematics and English if deficient in either area.
