3. Minutes. The minutes of the April 6, 1976 meeting were approved.
4. New Course Proposal. Human Nutrition (Health and Physical Education). Dr. J. Juechter presented some modifications for the proposed syllabus and moved the acceptance of the course. Extensive discussion followed on the history of interdepartmental communications between the Biology Department and the Health and Physical Education Department, concerning the development of a nutrition course at the college. At the end of a twenty minute period of discussion a motion to extend the time limit was approved.

Professor Kanuck submitted a motion to table this course proposal pending the formation of a subcommittee of the Curriculum Committee which would study all course proposals in nutrition, including interdisciplinary proposals at the college, and make recommendations to the full committee. 
Since the re-tally was abused by the alteration of a previous ballot, the chairperson ruled that the re-tally was out of order.
