MINUTES for April 9, 2014 (Approved 5/14/14)

The meeting commenced at 2:05 PM.

I. Approval of the Minutes of March 26th *Grace Campagna*

Minutes were distributed and reviewed. The Minutes of March 26th were approved, 14 in favor, 0 against, 3 abstaining: Hermina, Lee, Shen.

II. Subcommittee on Student Appeals *Monique Fortuné*

Monique Fortuné distributed an informational chart summarizing the recommendations of the April 2nd subcommittee. On that date, seven Administrative cases were reviewed of which four were granted and three were denied; no Statute of Limitations or Dismissal cases were reviewed. An additional 18 Administrative cases and 18 Statute of Limitations cases were tabled. As of today, a further ten Administrative cases and 19 Statute of Limitations cases are pending. A motion to approve the recommendations of the April 2nd subcommittee as to the seven Administrative cases was approved unanimously. Monique Fortuné noted the next subcommittee meeting will be held on April 30th and that enough CAS members have signed up for that date.

III. Old Business *Isabel Mirsky*

- A. Limit to Course Repetitions: This item is tabled pending receipt of data from Institutional Research.
- B. CAS Ability to Address F Grades: This item is tabled to allow departments to provide feedback as to whether attendance is or can be taken at final exams.

IV. New Business *Isabel Mirsky*

Pathways Course Substitutions for Transfer Credit: Isabel Mirsky explained that under the pre-Pathways curricula, course substitution decisions were made by the department offering the course in question. However, the Pathways Flexible Core areas each cover multiple departments, and thus a new policy is needed to review transfer credits for

Pathways students. (Departmental decisions as to transfer credit substitutions for required courses are not affected.) CAS will be developing language to amend the relevant sections of the Codification.

V. Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at 3:00 PM. The next CAS meeting will take place on Wednesday, April 23rd in the South Hall Conference Room.
